HIV and AIDS do not discriminate

In 2004,

- 40 million people were living with AIDS
- 64% of people living with HIV/AIDS were in sub-Saharan Africa
- 76% of all young people living with HIV in sub-Saharan Africa were female
- 4.9 million people were newly infected with HIV
- 3.1 million people died because of AIDS
- 12 million children became orphans because of AIDS
- a projected 25 million children will be orphaned by 2010 because of AIDS
